What is Healthwatch?

Healthwatch is here to demonstrably influence commissioning, service provision or strategic decision making...

We were delighted to be invited to the opening of the new Avon and Wiltshire Mental Health Partnership NHS Trust facility at Callington Road Hospital on 20th February 2018.

What did we hear?

The new unit is where a service user may go during the day to access services which have been identified in their care plan to support them and to return home at the end of the day.

It's an alternative to hospital admission but supports recovery.

The service is a way to enable Intensive Teams help to work in different ways to manage service users across the community.

A facility to support discharge and help to reduce re-admission to hospital.

Helps support both service users' physical and mental health.

Who did we meet?

We met with various ward staff, NHS clinical leads, commissioners and the managers at the trust, to be introduced to the different team members. Healthwatch has statutory powers to Enter and View CQC Regulated facilities and the information discussed helped us to plan our visits for the future. We agreed to come back later this year to follow up with a more formal Enter and View meeting, and an informal coffee morning with service users.
