Online survey: information, advice and support needs about COVID-19 in the Royal Borough of Windsor & Maidenhead






93 responses were received.

## Who completed the survey?






Do people feel informed about looking after their family, friends and people they know during the current Covid-19 pandemic?


The majority of people who responded, 74%, told us they did feel informed.

The 26% who said they did not feel informed were from across the whole spectrum of age groups.
