A Glance over our Engagement

In July 2021 we engaged with approximately **7,000** people across Stoke-on-Trent. This comprises, phone calls, emails, social media, our website, outreach events and meetings that we attended. More precisely we engaged with:

We identified a new Stoke-on-Trent Dentist Directory to share with people who need a dentist

We shared information on how to access PALS to allow 8 people to voice concerns with their hospital

We created a new step-by-step guide on how to book a blood test for patient ease

In receipt of public concerns, we were able to share this feedback in 8 individual meetings to represent the voice of local people
