Over half the people we spoke to said 'No'. 26% didn't know if they



- Loud
- Busy
- Bright
- overwhelming

Services said...

South Yorkshire Integrated Care Board is working with NHS England to:

- Make sure reasonable adjustments are both recorded and provided to patients.
- Add a digital reasonable adjustment flag to patients records.

Some people said services were flexible and explained things well

The law says that reasonable adjustments should be put in place.

Rotherham Hospital is:

- Making patient information easier to read by using plain English.
- Making information available in easy read to anyone who asks for it.
- Developing easy read appointment letters.
- Looking to provide more quiet space for people to wait in.

A health passport tells people all about you and how they can help you best.

Some healthcare staff felt they hadn't had enough training about passports

Those who had a health passport told us healthcare staff don't read it

Services said...

South Yorkshire Integrated Care Board is working with NHS England to:

- **Develop their website to** encourage more people to use health passports.
- Make health passports better.

Rotherham Hospital is:

- Promoting the use of health passports.
- Putting up to date links for all health passports on their website.
- Providing paper copies of health passports at their Communication Stations on the wards that can be handed out to patients.

You said...

"The doctors talk to my carer and not me..."

"They don't want to investigate my problem...they just put it down to being autistic" "As I was not screaming and being loud, my pain was not accepted as being...real"

Services said...

South Yorkshire Integrated Care Board is working with NHS England to:

 Make sure all NHS and social care staff have had Oliver McGowan training.

Rotherham Hospital has:

- Set up Communication Stations on wards that contain information and useful tools for staff to help them support autistic people and people with learning disabilities better.
- A learning disability and autism team who can provide extra support to patients, carers and staff.

You said...


"We are not offered yearly reviews...whereas when we lived [elsewhere] we did"



Over 400 people on the learning disability register in Rotherham didn't get an annual health check last year.



A further 3500 people have a learning disability in Rotherham but aren't on the learning disability register.
