

# The Queen Elizabeth Hospital Community Diagnostic Centre Feedback



**November 2025**

In November 2025 we visited The Queen Elizabeth Hospital Community Diagnostic Centre to speak with patients about their experience with health and social care services. From this visit we received 13 reviews for the centre. The reviews have an average star rating of 4.8 out of 5.


The Queen Elizabeth Hospital Community Diagnostic Centre is a Community Diagnostic Centre based at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital in the town of Kings Lynn. Upon their last inspection in January 2022, the Queen Elizabeth Hospital received a rating of "requires improvement", from the CQC. The Queen Elizabeth Hospital Community Diagnostic Centre offers a variety of services including CT, MRI and ultrasound scans.

Healthwatch Norfolk Officers who visited The Queen Elizabeth Hospital Community Diagnostic Centre noted:

- Healthwatch Norfolk Officers were welcomed by reception staff.
- There was a quiet waiting area with plenty of seating.
- The centre was clearly labelled from the hospital car park and on the outside of the building.
- There were accessible parking bays outside the unit, which were shared with other departments close by. During our visit, some people were unable to find a suitable space but were able to use the hospital buggy service from the main car park.
- The buggy service was observed dropping off and picking up patients and other visitors at regular intervals during our visit.

Overall, people were happy with the care they received at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital Community Diagnostic Centre. Many people felt that staff were friendly and that they were seen quickly. A couple of people did raise that there was some confusion over where they had to go for their appointment.
